

**MINUTES OF 419<sup>th</sup> (SPECIAL) MEETING OF REGISTRATION COMMITTEE HELD ON 08.07.2020 (10:00 Hrs) THROUGH VIDEO CONFERENCE.**

The 419<sup>th</sup> Meeting (Special) of the Registration Committee (RC) was held under the Chairmanship of Dr. S. K. Malhotra, Agriculture Commissioner & Chairman, Registration Committee on 29.05.2020 at 10:00 Hrs onwards through NIC video conference. Sh. Rajesh Malik, Director (PP) & PPA; DR C. D Tripathi, Professor Emeritus, Department of Pharmacology, VMMC and S J Hospital, New Delhi; Dr. Rajan, In charge ADG (PP) ICAR, Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi; Dr. S. P. Sahni, / Dr I.S. Hura (Representative of Drug Controller General of India), New Delhi and Dr. J. P. Singh, Secretary, CIB&RC attended the meeting.

The Experts/ Officers from the Secretariat of CIB&RC attended the meeting to present their agenda and volunteered to provide the information/advise during the deliberations, were Dr. Sushil K. Khurana, Consultant (Pathology); Dr. Sandhya Kulshrestha, Consultant (Pharma); Dr. Sarita Bhalla, Consultant (Pharma); Dr Vandana Seth, JD(Chem) CIL; Sh. Hari Om Miglani, Sr.LO; Sh. Kiran W. Deshkar, DD (E); Ms. Sneha Poddar, DD (Chem); Dr. Vandana Pandey, AD (PP); Sh. Avnish Tomar, AD (Chem.); Sh. Niraj Kulshrestha, LO, Ms. Raunaq, AD (Chem).

At the outset, Chairman welcomed the members & experts and asked Secretary, CIB&RC to take up the agenda for deliberations. The decisions taken by the RC are as under:

<b><u>Agenda item No.</u></b>	<b><u>Particulars of Agenda</u></b>
<b>1.0</b>	<b>Confirmation of minutes of the 418<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Registration Committee.</b>
	<p>RC deliberated the minutes of 418<sup>th</sup> RC meeting and confirm the following with some modification:</p> <p>1. Agenda 11.4: - Replaced with and should be read as “RC deliberated the issue and directed the Sectt. of CIB&amp;RC to maintain a separate que of the applications received under category FIM vs FIT and Seed Treatment in accordance to their date of receipt in the Sectt. and their disposal should be prioritized accordingly”.</p> <p>RC further decided efforts should be made to clear pending cases and agenda of all complete cases (as per que) of 9(3) FIM including seed treatment, 9(3) TIM and 9(4) TIM should be brought to the forthcoming RC to promote make in India endeavor.</p>

<b>1.1</b>	<b>Non submission of details/data of import or indigenous manufacturing by the registrants.</b>
	<p>RC deliberated the agenda and observed that in view of its decision whereby the RC felt it expedient to seek the details of import/manufacture being a regulatory authority under the Insecticides Act, 1968 and further that the registrant require to submit details of import or manufacturing (as the case may be) of the pesticides month wise mandatory to the Secretariat of CIB&amp;RC. In case of noncompliance of this condition the Committee may consider to cancel the CR without any notice. RC further observed that many of the registrants are not complying with the above condition which is recorded on the CR.</p> <p>RC further perused Rule 15 (5) of the Insecticides Rules, 1971 which envisage that the Central Government or the State Government any other person authorizes by the Central Government or the State Government as the case may be may seek the aforesaid information from the manufacturers/importers. In view of above RC decided that DAC&amp;FW may be requested to issue appropriate directions/instructions in accordance with law.</p>
<b>1.2</b>	<b>Status of certificate issued subject to NMR</b>
	<p>Committee deliberated the Agenda in detail and decided as under: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Priority for analysis of PRV samples at CIL shall be given to those samples which are close to their expiry date.</li> <li>2. CIL should explore more number of Laboratories with NMR facilities to clear all the pending samples at the earliest.</li> <li>3. CIL shall submit ATR with all Tests including NMR.</li> <li>4. Henceforth, Sectt. of CIBRC shall submit Agenda for 9(3) and 9(4) cases, wherever applicable with complete ATR of CIL including NMR</li> <li>4 Henceforth, issuance of CRs (including cases approved by RC and CRs not yet issued) under all category of 9(3) and 9(4) cases shall be done only after affirmative NMR report.</li> </ol>
<b>1.3</b>	<b>Issue of registration certificate for the grant of registration for Tricentanol</b>
	<p>The Committee deliberated the agenda and observed that as per agenda item no 9.57 of the 378 RC a group of expert was constituted and asked to submit its report within 60 days. As no report is submitted by the group and many experts has transferred/ superannuated hence, RC decided to reconstitute the expert group to examine the issue and other related issues such as the products had been registered under 9(4) FIM, while they are technical compounds, as discussed in this RC. The Committee directed the group to submit its report to the next RC.</p> <p>The expert group constituted is as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Dr. Sandhya Kulshrestha, Consultant (Pharma) Chairperson</li> <li>2. Sh. A. K. Reddy DD (Weed Science), member</li> <li>3. Sh. Avnish Tomar AD (Chem), member</li> <li>4. <b>1.4</b>	<b>Follow up action of 412<sup>th</sup> vide agenda no. 8.8 &amp; 413<sup>th</sup> RC vide agenda no. 10.49 held on December, 2019 &amp; March, 2020</b>
	<p>RC deliberated the issue in view of the agenda item no. 8.8 of the 412<sup>th</sup> RC and item no 10.49 of the 413 RC wherein it was finally decided to grant final opportunity to the applicant to submit their clarification within 15 days of uploading of minutes of 413<sup>th</sup> RC failing which appropriate legal action shall entail in accordance with law. A Public Notice dated 28.04.2020 was hoisted on CIB&amp;RC website providing list of 42 companies/firms (as provided to CIB &amp; RC by the Companies) for authorized person issuing the affidavit of consent for technical grade material. A total 50 applications in this context of fake affidavits were meticulously verified.</p> <p>The Committee deliberated the agenda and noted that there are certain discrepancies in the list which was placed before the RC by the then dealing expert and desired that the same may be properly rectified after going through the records and further, the same shall be placed in the next RC. The Committee further directed the Secretariat of CIB &amp; RC to expeditiously draft and initiate FIR against the guilty persons who have provided fake consent letter thus, prima facie have committed the offenses of cheating and forgery.</p> <p>A total of 22 cases have been identified for filing FIR as decided by the RC held on 08.07.2020 at <b>Annexure</b> Verification of the remaining cases to be done on priority and shall be apprised in the next RC.</p>
<b>2.0</b>	<b>Any Other Item</b>
<b>2.1</b>	<b>Revisit current guidelines for registration of pesticide u/s 9(3) and 9(4) of the Insecticides Act, 1968:</b>
	<p>RC was informed that a Sub-committee was constituted in 413<sup>th</sup> RC meeting held on 03.03.2020 to revisit the current guidelines for registration of pesticides. However, the meeting of the Sub-committee could not be held due to non-availability of members initially and then due to lock-down and other Covid-19 related issues. Only one internal meeting has been held till date. RC directed the Sub-committee to complete this task on priority and submit report by 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2020.</p>
