PUBLIC NOTICE

The Registration Committee, constituted by the Central Government under Section 5 of the Insecticides Act, 1968, had registered a combination of Streptomycin Sulphate and Tetracycline Hydrochloride as 9:1 % w/w, which implies (90%+10% w/w). However, in some of the certificates, the same appears to be 9%+1% (w/w) alongwith 90% (w/w) adjuvant. This created an anomaly, which needed clarity and harmonization to avoid confusion. The Registration Committee discussed the issue in 227th meeting vide Agenda Item No. 3.3. The relevant portion of the minutes of the said meeting read as under-

"The Committee deliberated and approved the chemical composition of the combination product in the ratio of 90:10. The Committee also directed that chemical composition in the ratio of 90:10 may be incorporated in the registration certificates granted earlier under Section 9 (4)."

This decision somehow could not get implemented. Therefore, the Registration Committee in its 342nd meeting considered the issue again vide Agenda Item No. 3.1. The relevant portion of minutes of the said meeting read as under:-

"The Committee reiterated its decision taken in 227th Meeting held on 20.10.2002 and directed the Secretariat to issue a Public Notice in this regard on its website."

In compliance, the decision is hereby notified. All concerned may get their Certificates of Registration corrected accordingly.
