Plant Quarantine, Jamnagar (Gujarat)

<u>Aims</u>

- To facilitate export certification of plants and plant products for safe global trade in agriculture/ horticulture by fulfilling WTO-SPS agreement so as to gain access to global market for our agricultural products.
- To adopt safe plant quarantine practices to protect our environment.

Activities

- ✓ Export inspection and Phytosanitary Certification of plants and plant products in conformity with quarantine regulations of the importing country.
- ✓ Laboratory analysis for detection and identification of insect pests, diseases and weed seeds in export samples of plants and plant products.
- ✓ Supervision of treatment for disinfestations/disinfection of plant materials.
- ✓ To conduct inspection in APEDA recognised Peanut shelling-grading as well as processing unit for export to ensure effective phytosanitary certification according to SOP for Peanut export to both EU and Non EU countries.
- ✓ To facilitate Export, Phyto-Sanitary Certification of Plants and Plant products for safe global trade in Agricultural commodities and thereby fulfilling legal obligations under WTO-SPS international agreements and International Plant Protection Convention 1951 (IPPC).
- ✓ To supervise fumigation operations of export consignments carried out by accredited fumigation agencies, as per PQ Order, 2003 / Standard Operating Procedures.
