

Report of One day training program on PP equipments for DCM and MTS

Locust Warning Organization (LWO), Jodhpur has mandate for locust control in India. There are ten Locust Circle Offices (LCOs) and one Field Station for Investigations on Locust (FSIL) functioning under control of the LWO, Jodhpur. Locust Control operation require use of different types of equipments for spraying the pesticides. Most of the spray equipments are imported from U.K. There is a need for regular servicing, repair and maintenance of these equipments. Two mechanics posted at LWO Jodhpur are trained under FAO assistance for servicing, repair and maintenance of these equipments. Many new DCM & MTS have joined at LCO/LWO, who do not have experience in repair, servicing & maintenance of the spray equipments. Further, some of the trained mechanics are in the verge of superannuation. Therefore, it was felt essential to utilize the services of the trained mechanics in training the newly joined MTS & DCM. The one day training program on PP equipments (ULV sprayers) such as Micronair, Ulvamast and Ulva plus was organized on 23.03.2022 (Wednesday) at the Work shop of Locust Warning Organization, Jodhpur. The 15 nos. of DCM & MTS from different LCOs of Rajasthan and Gujarat participated in this training program. Agenda of the one day training program on PP equipments (ULV sprayers) is attached at **Annexure-I**.

Resource Persons:

The two skilled persons of LWO, Jodhpur *i.e.* Sh. Dharma Ram Meghwal, DCM and Sh. Virendra Vyas, DCM who are trained for repair, servicing & maintenance of PP equipments from Oman (sponsored by FAO) were the resource persons. Both are well versed with maintenance and repair of PP equipments used in DL control.

Participants:

Total 15 participants were selected for the training of PP equipments (ULV sprayers) from different LCOs of Rajasthan and Gujarat states based on age, education and tenure of service (10 years) left. A list of trainee's participants is annexed at **Annexure-II**.

Registration of the participants:

The registration of the participants was from 09:30 AM to 10:00 AM and with registration, the participants were provided with a Note pad & a pen.

Inaugural Session:

Inaugural session started with welcome address by Dr. Virendra Kumar, Assistant Director (PP) Officer In-charge, Locust Warning Organization, Jodhpur. In his welcome address, he encouraged all the participants to adopt participatory approach during the course of training. It was also emphasized that the participants use their practical experience in order to improve their

skill. The function was formally inaugurated by Dr. Shaloo Ayri, Deputy Director (Entomology) Locust Division, Directorate of Plant Protection, Quarantine & Storage, H.Q. Faridabad by lighting the lamps followed by other officials.

Dr. Ayri addressed participants and emphasized that, this training is necessary for DCM and MTS as they are actual real ground players and are backbone of Locust unit who performed active role in Locust control operations, therefore hands on training of PP equipments is need of hour so that any fault in equipments can be rectified immediately in the field itself. The aim of this training was to generate more skilled hands.

Pre-evaluation & Post evaluation Test:

In order to evaluate the skill of the participants, a pre & post-evaluation test was conducted. The test paper comprised of conventional type of questions related to PP equipments. All trainee participants attempted the pre and post-evaluation test. The comparative result of pre evaluation / post evaluation test is given at **Annexure-III.**

Technical Session:

During technical session master trainer briefed participants about the ULV sprayers like their working principle, how effectively utilize the resources, how to maintain the equipment while in control operation as well as during storage. After theoretical discussion practical demonstration on PP equipments such as Micronair, Ulva mast and Ulva plus was given in presence of Dr. Shaloo Ayri, Deputy Director (Ento.) and other officials.

In this training, participants were asked to dismantle PP equipments for practical exercise followed by refitting and make them available in working condition. Few photograph of training programme are displayed at **Annexure-IV**.

Wrap up:

At the end of the one day training program on PP equipments all the activities undertaken during the course of one day training were once again briefed to the participants and doubts were clarified through group discussion.
